

Call for WiMob 2009 Workshop Proposals

The 5th IEEE International Conference on Wireless and Mobile Computing, Networking and Communications (WiMob 2009) will be held in Marrakech, Morocco, 12-14 October 2009 (http://www.larim.polymtl.ca/wimob2009).

As an important part of the program at WiMob 2009, a limited number of workshops will be held in conjunction with the main conference. The workshops aim to explore special topics and provide international forums for researchers to present their early research results and share experiences with focus on more specific research areas than the main conference.

We solicit workshops in all areas and topics related to wireless networking, mobile computing, mobile and wireless communications, pervasive computing and networking, and its services and applications.

All papers accepted in WiMob 2009 workshops will be published in the WiMob 2009 Proceedings published by IEEE. The workshops will be held on 12 October 2009.

The workshop proposal should contain the following information:

- 1. The title of the workshop.
- 2. The names, addresses, and affiliation of Workshop organizers.
- 3. A brief description of the workshop (eg. the goals and its relevance, etc.).
- 4. The names of potential program committee members (TPC).
- 5. Expected number of submissions.
- 6. A description of the publicity plan (including an URL address).
- 7. Due dates (camera-ready papers need to be submitted at latest by mid August).
- 8. A draft call for papers (CFP).

Workshop organizers should send their workshop proposals to the workshop co-chairs at the email addresses given below by 2 March 2009. The proposals can be submitted in PDF or plain text. Acceptance/rejection notification will be sent to workshop organizers by 15 March 2009.
