



#### Paper Prepared Using LaTeX

To submit your paper, you should upload a zip archive (with the extension .zip) and a PDF file. The archive must contain the LaTeX source required to produce your paper. Both EasyChair and Springer Verlag should be up to date and contain CTAN LaTeX packages. However, you should include in the archive all non-standard or locally used LaTeX packages.

The main LaTeX file must be in the top directory of the archive. Other files may be put in either the top directory or subdirectories of the archive. If you use LaTeX, before you put the files in the archive please check that running `pdflatex` (or `latex`) on your main file produces no errors. On Unix-like systems you can create the archive using the following procedure. Assume that the main LaTeX file is `main.tex` and it is placed in the directory `papers/conf`.

Then use the following sequence of actions

```
cd papers/conf
latex main
... check that there are no error messages ...
zip -r mypaper.zip *
```

It will produce the zip file `mypaper.zip` that can be uploaded. Your paper will be produced again from the LaTeX source. We will then use your pdf file to compare it with the files obtained from the source.

The main file name may not contain whitespace characters or any of the following symbols: `\ / ' > < , ; " |`.
